## LAUBSCHER MEADOWS SANITARY LANDFILL

A presentation was made at the March 27 UNOE neighborhood meeting about the Laubscher Meadows Sanitary Landfill. This is the landfill in Vanderburgh County which is owned by Republic Services. This landfill, located on North St. Joseph Avenue, is a Subtitle D landfill which meets all environmental regulations stipulated by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) and the federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This landfill has been in existence for nearly 40 years, although the Subtitle regulations did not go into effect until a few years later, in approximately 1990. Laubscher Meadows has about 30 years of space remaining. When the landfill reaches its capacity, Republic Services must cover it with topsoil and maintain it, environmentally and in other ways, for 30 years.

The Laubscher Meadows Sanitary Landfill provides residential, commercial, and industrial waste service to the Evansville Metropolitan Area. It also provides waste service for the sludge generated by the Evansville Water and Sewer Utility.

This landfill can also be looked at from an economic development perspective. When a company is looking to possibly locate a plant in Evansville or the surrounding area, company officials not only look at the availability and cost of gas and electric service, of water and sanitary sewer service, and of roads, streets, and drainage, but also of the availability of environmental waste services.

One factor that Republic has generated from the Laubscher Meadows landfill is the sale of the methane gas generated by the landfill. All sanitary landfills generate methane gas as part of the decomposition of the waste that is deposited at the landfill. Many landfills just burn off the gas as part of the process. Laubscher Meadows captures the methane gas and pipes it to Mead Johnson which uses it for energy production.
